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Fairy problems included in the competition — orthodox help-self mate (hs#):


In a help-self mate white moves first, black and white cooperate until the last move of black, which must be forced checkmate to white, as in selfmate.

If half-move stipulation is given, (hs#2.5, hs#3.5), black moves first.
