

17th Baltic Solving Cup

RIGA, SATURDAY, 6 APRIL 2019 AT 12:00

Latvian and Lithuanian Chess problem societies kindly invite solvers to participate in the joint project by two neighbour countries – the 17th Baltic Solving Cup!

The competition is registered for the 4th World Solving Cup.

Tournament venue

The championship will take place in the Conference hall "BERLIN" of the 4-star hotel "Bellevue Park Hotel Riga" (www.hotelbellevue.lv), 1 Slokas Street, Riga (Latvia).

The hotel set in 2 km from the Riga Old Town, 8 km from the airport "Riga"; having free parking, free Wi-Fi Internet and a modern 11th floor panoramic restaurant "Le Sommet".

Period of time for the Event: 05.04 – 07.04.2019 (limited number of rooms available on the special rate!)

- Standard SGL (1 person in room): 30 EUR/per room, per night
- Standard twin/dbl (2 persons in room): 35 EUR/per room, per night

The above room rate includes access to the fitness room 24/7, cold & hot breakfast buffet at 1st floor PARK restaurant, as well 12% VAT and service charges, coffee & tea complimentary offer and parking a lot.

Format of competition

Same, as Latvian Championship 2018, the competition will include Fairy problem, hs# *.

Type: Open tournament – 2 rounds, 120 min. per round

7 problems in each round, 70 maximum points across all problems, every solved problem counts.

- 1st round: #2, #3, endgame, h#, #n, s# and a fairy problem hs#
- 2nd round: #2, #3, endgame, h#, #n, s# and a fairy problem hs#

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
*Fairy problem included in the competition – help self-mate, **hs#n**:
