

#### 3rd FUJAIRAH ENDURANCE CHESS SOLVING CHAMPIONSHIP 2020

Under the patronage of H.H. Sheikh Mohammed bin Hamad Al Sharqi, the Crown Prince of Fujairah, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Fujairah endurance chess solving championship 2020 set the new records: in the prize fund, the number of participants, and the highest rating of best solvers. It took place in the Novotel Hotel in Fujairah, in the frames of the 16<sup>th</sup> WFCC International Solving Contest that attracted the record number of 885 participants from 47 countries. The rise of interest for problem chess throughout the world is visible, and the role of UAE in it is getting more and more significance.

After the great international success of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Fujairah endurance chess solving championship 2019, the United Arab Emirates, represented by Dr Abdulla Ali AAL BARAKAT, president of the Fujairah chess & culture club, became an official member of the World Federation for Chess Composition (WFCC). It all added more of importance to the competition held on 25-26<sup>th</sup> January, traditionally including a blitz tourneys with a strong grandmasters field.

Both competitions, in chess and solving, were classified into 3 categories:

- 1. Open, but intended for participants with ELO or WFCC rating 2.000 and more,
- 2. For participants with ELO and WFCC rating bellow 2.000, and
- 3. Youth U13 competitions (born 2007 and younger).

For the first time both 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> categories were rated, and it allowed many local players to enter the WFCC Solvers' rating list. This year, Fujairah competition included 61 solvers in the WFCC list: 53 of them for the first time (half rating) and 8 with the full solvers' rating. Some famous chess grandmasters, like Bassem Amin, Gadir Guseinov and Alexander Moiseenko, faced rated solving competition for the first time.



#### **Exceptional conditions**

Under supervision of FIDE Arbiter Mohammad Abdul Ghani Hallak, and International arbiter Mahdi Abdulrahim, the luxurious space of the Novotel Hotel once again ensured exceptional conditions for solvers and players. The competition itself, as well as marking of solutions, was controlled by the members of the WFCC Youth Committee, Marjan Kovačević, Grandmaster of solving and composing chess problems, and Julia Vysotska, the webmaster of the WFCC.

In order to adjust to the international rules, new participants were acquainted with the kinds of problems they had never solved before: the helpmates and the selfmates. Also, they got to learn international rules about writing solutions.

The number of solvers raised almost 50% in comparison with previous year. There were 162 participants, 27 in Category 1, 45 in Category 2 and 90 in Category 3. Many of the foreign guests were impressed by the conditions Fujairah offers to this kind of solving competitions.





### More of the World and European champions in Fujairah

This year, competition in Fujairah attracted more of the world's best solvers, including the complete team of Poland, multiple World and European team champions. No wonder they occupied the first three places in Category 1. The winner was multiple individual World champion Kacper Piorun, ahead of Piotr Murdzia, the absolute recorder in winning individual World Championship, and the defender of title from previous year. The third prize went to Piotr Gorski, the reigning World champion in solving.

Right behind the mighty Polish trio, the fourth place went to Danila Pavlov from Russia, the reigning European champion in solving, ahead of Abdelaziz Onkoud from Morocco. Russia was represented on a high level too, with Andrey Selivanov, the reigning World champion in composing Self-mate problems, on the 6<sup>th</sup> place, and Oleg Pervakov, the reigning World champion in composing Endgames, on the 8<sup>th</sup> place. Between them was Maksim Romanov, another young talent from Russia.

Kacper Piorun celebrated double triumph. Being a strong Grandmaster, both in chess and solving, he won a very strong blitz tournament in Category 1, ahead of GM Gadir Guseinov, FM Danila Pavlov and GM Alexander Moiseenko.

Another proof that solving chess problems improves chess skill, was given by Serafim Bunin. The 12-years old boy from Russia, without Solvers' rating, convincingly won both the solving competition in Category 2(!) and the blitz competition in Category 3.

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### Successes of the young participants from UAE

The winner of solving competition in Category 3 was Rouda Essa Alserkal, the chess prodigy from United Arab Emirates, who won World Cadets U8 Championship in Brazil, in 2017. This time, the ten years old girl form Abu Dhabi proved her chess talent in beating all the boys under 13 years, among 90 solvers.

Even more important was her success on the World level, in the frames of the 16th ISC. Rouda had the second best result among girls in Category 3, where 453 U13 solvers competed. Right behind her, on the 3rd place, was Indian girl M.S. Harshavardhimi, who was also solving in Fujairah.

Last year's winner in Category 2, 15 years old Ammar Al Sedrani from Fujairah chess & culture club, moved this year to Category 1, according to his growing rating. It was hard task for him to adjust to the new level of difficulty, but he kept training enthusiastically his solving skills and simultaneously progressing in chess tournaments, with the help of his trainer, GM Igor Miladinović.
