
Memorial of Jozef Linder, Chess Composing Tourney on occasion of the 25th International Solving Championship of Slovakia

On occasion of the 25th International Solving Championship of Slovakia, held in Sliač, from April 22nd to April 23rd, 2017, the Slovak Chess Composition Organization (SOKŠ) announces an international composing tourney for orthodox twomovers. The following "theme" is required: orthodox twomover with at least two phases (solution, try, set play, twins). Every phase contains at least two defences with the same mates, but harmuful effects are changed. Fairy units or conditions are forbidden. Entries have to be emailed at the latest by April 1st, 2017 to marek.kolcak@gmail.com. Judge Karol Mlynka will receive the compositions without names of authors. The tourney is open worldwide. Book prizes are offered. A special prize (a bottle of slivovica) will be given to the best placed composer, participating at the Solving Championship. The award will be published during the prize-giving ceremony on April, 23rd, 2017 in Sliač.
