E1 - World Solving Cup

1nd February, Friday: arrival

2rd February, Saturday: 10:00, 1-3 rounds (twomovers, threemovers, studies)

3rd February, Sunday: 10:00, 4-6 rounds (helpmates, moremovers, selfmates)
18:00, Prize giving

E2 - Solving youth tournament

3rd February, Sunday: 10:00

120 minutes for 9 problems in one round (three two movers, two three movers, one four mover, one endgame studies, one helpmate in two, one selfmate in two.
18:00, Prize giving

The Prize fund is 150000 russian rubles (~ 2000 euros):

E1 - 130000 rubels for 6 winners and special prizes for women and seniors.

E2 – 20000 russian rubles.
