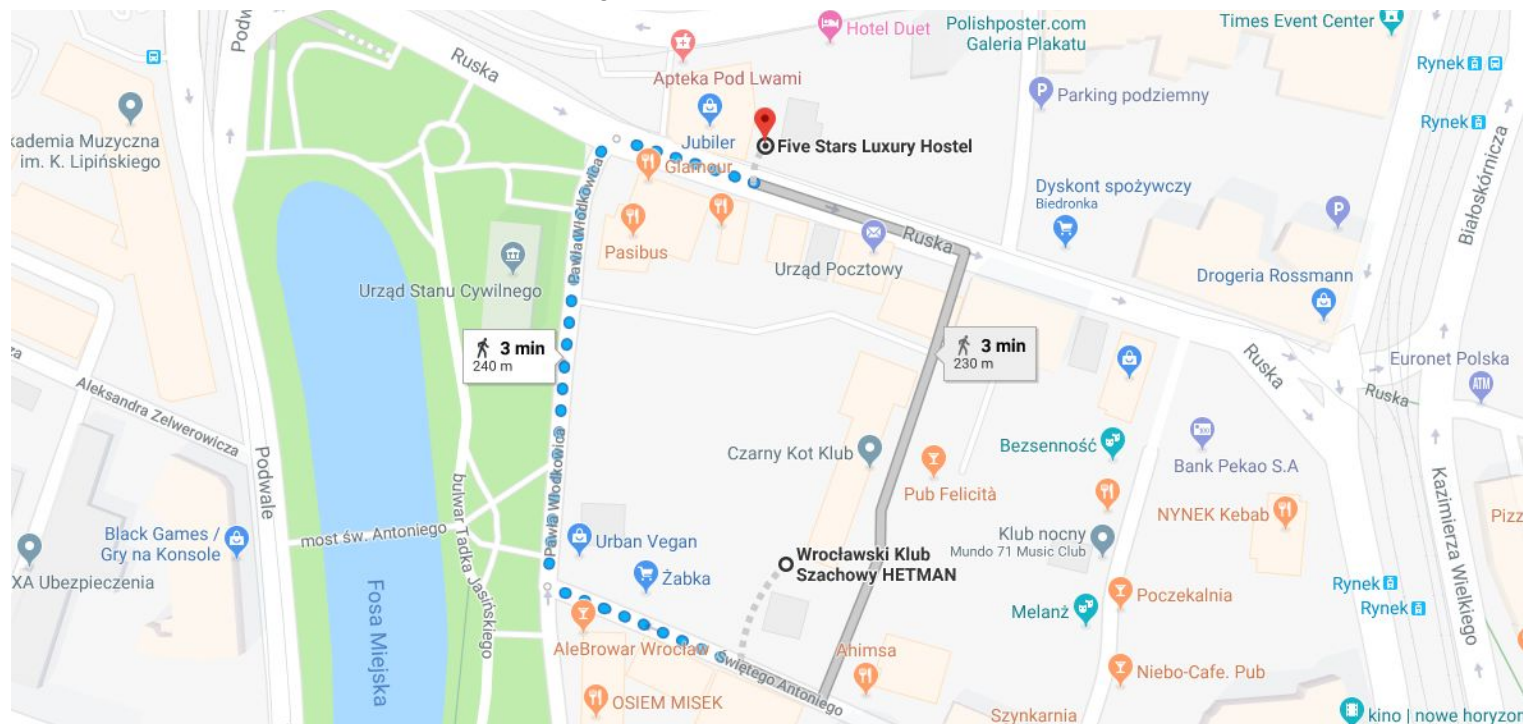
The entry is for free (no fee).

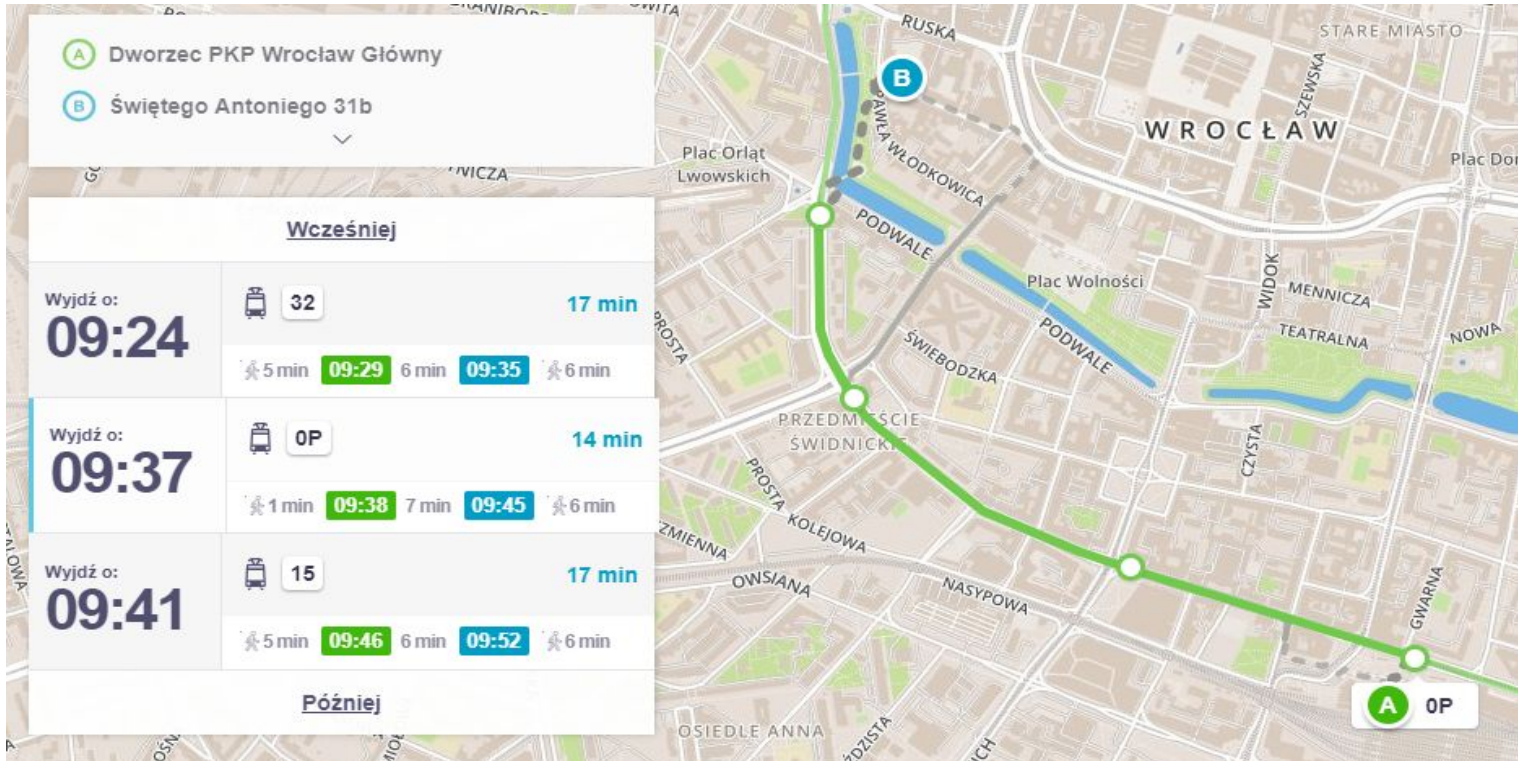

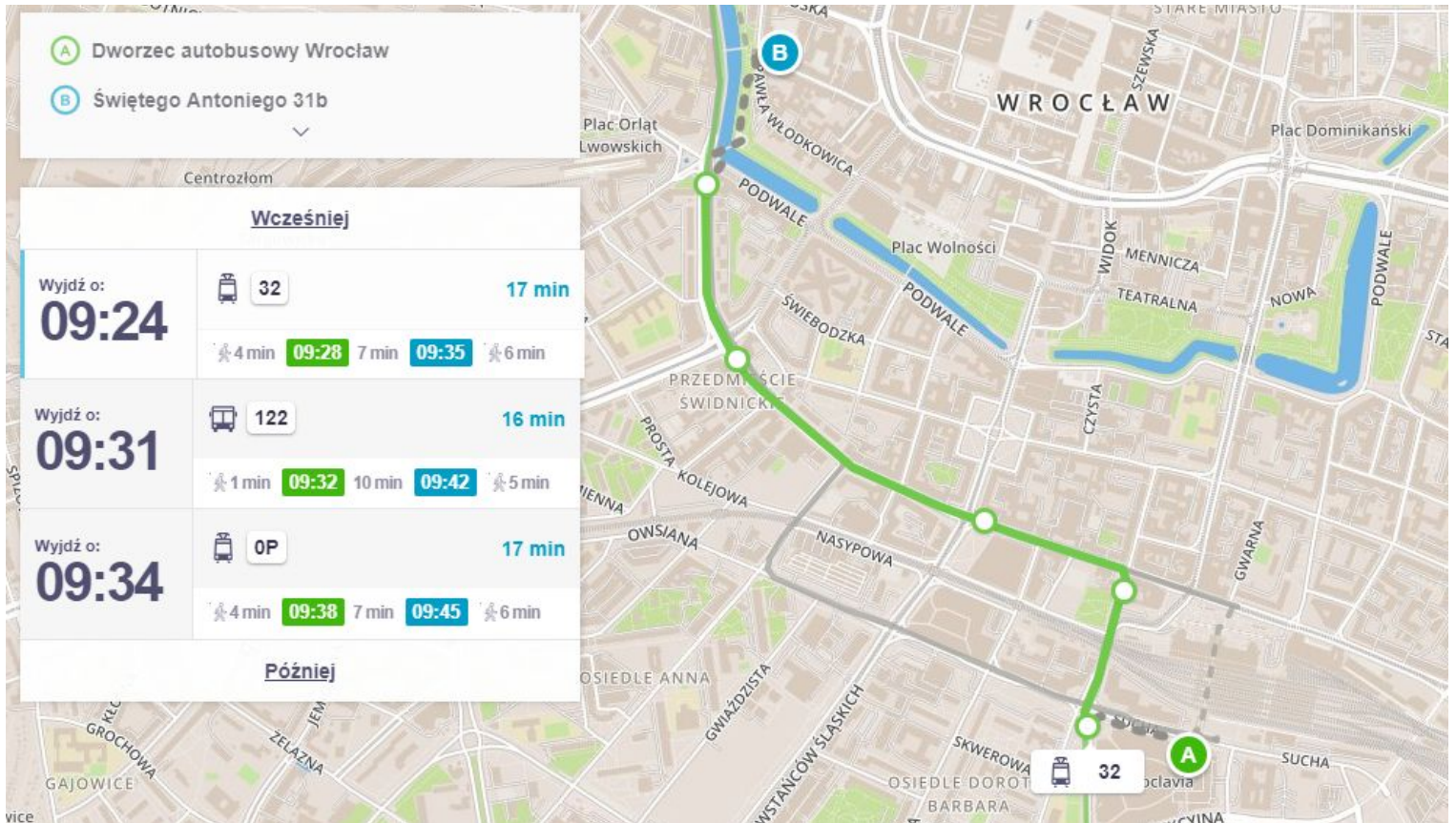
Approach Routes

As part of public transport in Wrocław, it is worth to use the [connection finder](#).

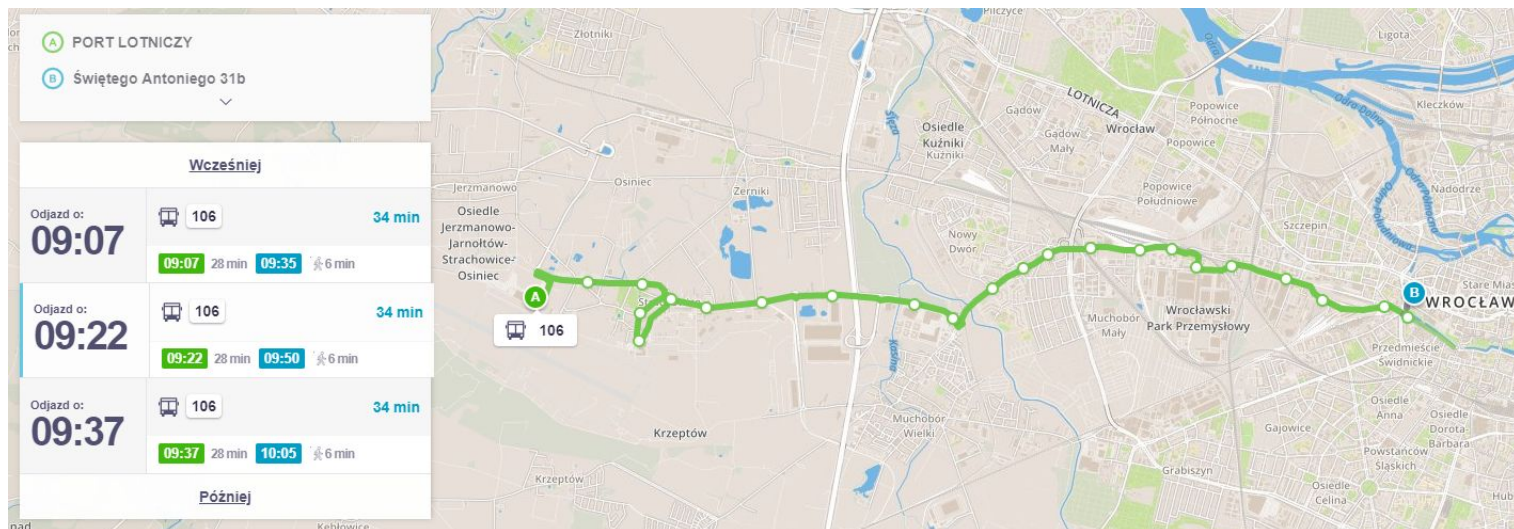
Route from the main railway station - 2,40 PLN - 17 min
