# Tournament venue

The championship will take place in the Conference hall "BERLIN" of the 4-star hotel "Bellevue Park Hotel Riga" (www.hotelbellevue.lv), 1 Slokas Street, Riga (Latvia).

7 problems in each round, 70 maximum points across all problems, every solved problem counts.

- 1<sup>st</sup> round: #2, #3, endgame, h#, #n, s# and a fairy problem hs#
- 2<sup>nd</sup> round: #2, #3, endgame, h#, #n, s# and a fairy problem hs#
