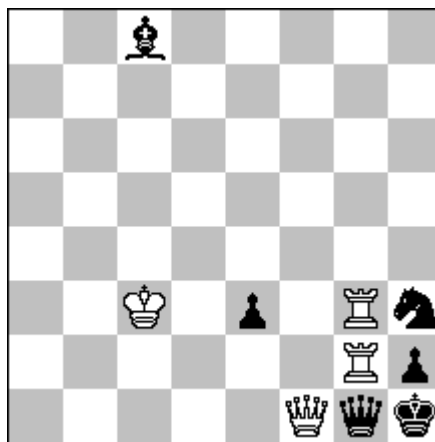
**Chess Composing Tourney

The following “theme” is required: The key enables at least two checks to white king. Twins are allowed. Fairy units or conditions are forbidden. Entries have to be emailed at latest by April 4th, 2019 to oto.mihalco@gmail.com. Judge Karol Mlynka will receive the compositions without names of authors. The tourney is open worldwide. Book prizes are guaranteed. A special prize (a bottle of slivovica) will be given to the best placed composer, participating at the Solving Championship. The award will be published during the prize-giving ceremony on April, 14th, 2019 in Bratislava.
