Time: Saturday, 5th October 2019, local time: 11:00 (CET).

Internationally, we suggests that the tourney will be held at CET 11:00.

There will be one round (150 minutes) with 15 twomovers to solve.

 \cdot Wednesday, 2nd October 2019 - The local controllers will receive all necessary documents by e-mail no later than this date.

 \cdot Local controllers should send results from the program by the end of the day on Saturday, 5th October. All other results will be disregarded

 Sunday, 6th October, 2019 – Cumulative results will be published on <u>http://www.matplus.net</u>. Since this is the non-rated tournament and there are only twomovers to solve (very easy for local controllers to check solutions) the results will be final and there will be no preliminary results published. The local controllers are obligated to publish preliminary results at their location and to resolve any solver claims before they send results to the main controller.

Please note that only the tourneys held in Serbia will count for the Serbian Solving League.

Top places are guaranteed diplomas, which will be given in the congress in Rhodes next year.
