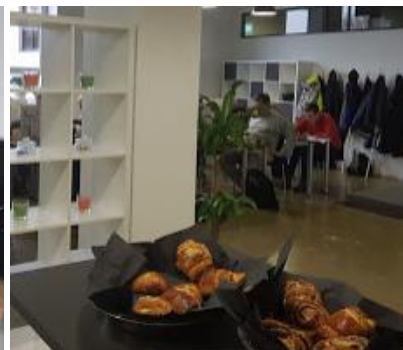


Hotels on 600-700m distance, about 28-32 EUR/night for single room at Booking.com:
