

Solving Tournament of Martynas Limontas 2021.03.14

Introduction

1. This solving tournament is a special event, organised at a period when the traditional live solving tournaments can't be held because of the worldwide pandemic of the Coronavirus in 2021. There are no prizes. It doesn't count for rating. It is not possible to make norms or win titles.

2. Tournament director is Arvydas Mockus (arvydas.mockus@gmail.com)

3. The solvers will receive the diagrams by e-mail and must solve the problems immediately at home.

4. After finishing their session, the solvers mail their solutions immediately to the tournament director. Complete results will be published as soon as possible.

Registration

1. All the solvers who have or had more than 2000 elo are invited. Other players may be invited by the tournament director.

2. The solver must be registered before the tournament starts. He informs director Arvydas Mockus. Closing date of registration is Saturday 13 March 2021 at 20.00 GMT.

Organization

The tournament takes place on Sunday 14 March 2021at 10.00 CET (= London 09.00; Brussels 10.00; Moscow 12.00; Tokyo 18.00)

Selection

There will be 2 rounds (105 min. per round) with 6 problems in each to solve.

1st round: #2, #3, endgame, h#2, #n, s#3.

2nd round: #2, #3, endgame, h#3, #n, s#2.

Tournament

1 Round: At exactly 10.00 CET an e-mail with the problems will be sent to every participant. The solvers will be solving at home till 11.45. The solvers will have 5 minutes to submit their solutions by e-mail to the address mentioned above.

2 Round: At exactly 12.00 CET an e-mail with the problems will be sent to every participant. The solvers will be solving at home till 13.45. The solvers will have 5 minutes to submit their solutions by e-mail to the address mentioned above.

A solver can of course forward his solutions before the end of his session. You can use photo, scan, doc file, etc.

After the tournament

After 15 minutes the solvers will receive the solutions from the director. The tournament director will mark immediately the solution sheets, and publish thepreliminary results as soon as possible (probably in the early evening). Because the solver has still his own solving sheet and the document with the solutions, he can easily check himself how many points he has. If he is not sure about something, he can always ask the director for clarification.

Fair-play

The director trusts all players that they will not use any helping devices (computer, books,...) while solving. This can not and will not be checked by the director. The director believe in the honesty of all the participants and that they will show respect for the other competitors by adhere strictly to this rule.

Finally

All unforeseen events (undelivered mails, etc.) will be handled by the tournament director with common sense.
