Registration is optional but preferred (if only to identify a name rather than your eMail address for the Results and Final Report). Points are awarded according to WCSC guidelines. Results and Final Reports will be published as quickly as possible in the usual way; and also by eMail to all entrants.

For each GP, BOOM points will be awarded to the top 10 solvers as follows:
