C13 — three variations met in miniature E.Markov "The Problemist", 2001, www.yacpdb/70256. To implement the fourth variation, the author added 18 pieces. In this case, four white pieces 單b3, 罩e4, 盈a1 and 全d3 in the solution do not play.


C18 – The first move takes away the free square from the black King. In both variations the repetition of the second and third moves.

C25 – zero-position with multiple permutations. The first two twins repeat five moves in a row.
