7 selfmates on anonymous diagrams I was received by the Director of the tourney.

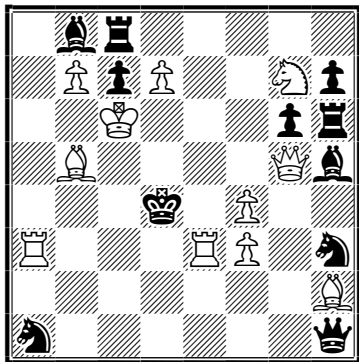

League of The Macedonian Problemist, 2016 (Appendix II). I not included in the award no.F027 because of dual mates on the same square (f:g2, h:g2#). My main criteria in judging were originality, complexity, economy, and the overall artistic effect. From the rest problems I proposal following ranking.:

I will change my award in order of No.F07. This problem is only better version of the previous problem by W. Tura 1.Pr V. Bron 110 MT 2019.

I will excluded this problem (2.HM by W. Tura) from the award, because of self-anticipation.
