

Piece definitions

Triton: move as Rook but capture by hopping over and removing an adverse unit, landing on the next (necessarily empty) square

Siren: move as Queen but capture by hopping over and removing an adverse unit, landing on the next (necessarily empty) square

Nereid: move as Bishop but capture by hopping over and removing an adverse unit, landing on the next (necessarily empty) square

Nightrider Hopper: a nightrider that must hop over a piece along the nightrider line





AUW & Pickaninny

In two solution the black knight is sacrificed while in the other two solutions it makes selfblocks.

Judges Vlaicu Crișan and Eric Huber wrote:

"The thematic combination enthused us from the start: white Allumwandlung and Pickaninny, made for the first time in helpselfmate. In the first two solutions the black Knight is sacrificed actively in order to be captured by the white piece promoted on W1. In the other two solutions, the bS is a self-blocker, and the promoted white piece is sacrificed in order to be captured by the Pickaninny bP. This wP-bP duel in 4 phases represents a remarkable and unique achievement in this tourney, hence the first place."






