



In addition, there is a small "geography" in the problem: B and R give mates from the square on which R and B stand in the initial position. This provision is not fictitious, since it determines the sequence of moves. The f6 is an important square, through which first two black pieces pass, and then one of the white knights plays."




The tourney judge Vlaicu Crişan: "I couldn't initially believe my eyes: this is pure perfection, with 8 every single move from each twin being in diagonal-orthogonal correspondence. The key is a surprising foresight prospective pinning, with the black piece getting indirectly pinned after the annihilation of the innocent looking white Pawn and the splendid well conceived hideaway of its capturer. Two pairs of pieces exchange roles: wRc5/wBe6 and bRb5/bBf7. So, why not a Prize?! Well, there are just some very tiny details to ponder. First, the strategic conception is somehow less ambitious compared to the prize winners. Secondly, there are three white pieces which are solely guarding black King flights. Thirdly, there is limited interplay. And finally: the initial setting and play remembered me Franz Pachl's unforgettable 17th Sternstunden (see Appendix IV), but nicely extended with additional motivations. Nevertheless, this charming and artistic presentation is perhaps the most aesthetically satisfying from the whole tournament. My deep congratulations and admiration to the author!"




