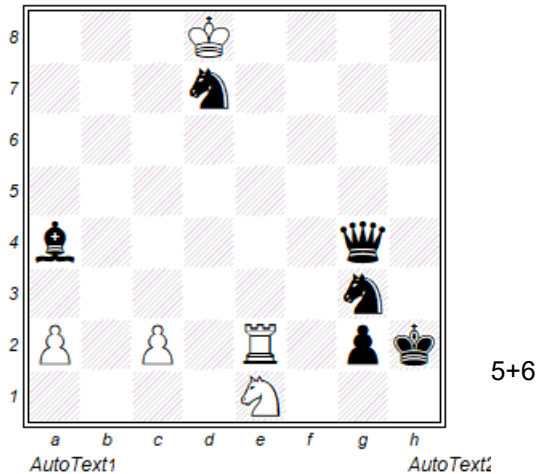

Basic plan:

1.Ke8-d8? & fw.1.R:g2(Rh1)#? Yet & fw.1...S:h1(Sg8)!

The preparation plan:

1.d6:Bc7(c2)! Bb8-c7+? 2.b5:a6ep(a2) a7-a5

3.Kc7-d8! Sf8-d7+ 4.Kd7-c7 Se6-f8+ [Qg8-g4+?]

5.b4-b5 Bb,c,d-a4+ [position for the first time]

6.Kc7-d7 Sf8-e6+ 7.Kd7-c7 Se6-f8+

8.Kc7-d7 Sf8-e6+ 9.Kd7-c7 Qg8-g4+[forced]

10.Ke8-d7 & fw.1.R:g2(Rh1)# would work

since g8 is occupied but Black has a better defence:

1.d6:Bc7(c2) Sf8-d7+! [instead of Bb8-c7+]

2.b5:a6ep(a2) a7-a5 White starts a pendulum

3.Kd7-d8 Se6-f8+ 4.Kd8-d7 Sf8-e6+ 5.Kd7-d8 Se6-f8+

6.Kd8-d7 Bb8-c7+ now this black move is forced enabling

White to continue as intended in W3 of the preparation plan:

7.Kc7-d8 Sf8-e6+ 8.Kd7-c7 Se6-f8+ [Qg8-g4+?]

9.b4-b5 Bb,c,d-a4+ [the same position as after the 5th

move of the preparation plan occurs for the first time and

White is finishing successfully with another pendulum:

10.Kc7-d7 Sf8-e6+ 11.Kd7-c7 Se6-f8+12.Kc7-d7 Sf8-e6+

13.Kd7-c7 Qg8-g4+ [forced] 14.Ke8-d7 & fw.1.R:g2(Rh1)#

[The forward defence ...3.Kd7-d8 Se6-f8+ & fw. 1.Qd7#? is excluded by type Cheylan].

Theme:

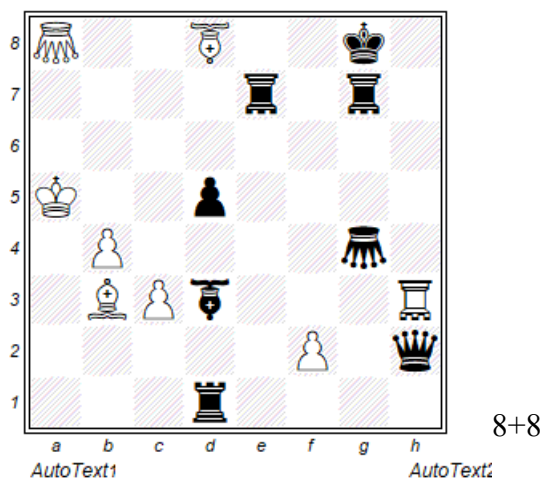
To reach 1.R:g2(Rh1)# white must occupy g8, the square of origin of bSg3 which is guarding h1. By means of 2 interlinked pendulums bQ is decoyed to g8.

1.Ga8:Ra4(Ga8)! Kh8-g8+ 2.BHh4:Bd8(BHd8) Qc7-h2+

3.Gd6:RHa3(Ga8) Ra1-d1+ 4.Pe5:RHf6(Pf2) Qb6-c7

5.Gh2-d6 Qc7-b6 [5...Pd7-d5? 6.RHh7-h3 & fw. 1.BH:e7(BHe8)#]

6.Ba2-b3 [starts a pendulum] **Qb6-c7 7.Bb3-a2 Qc7-b6**

8.Ba2-b3 Qb6-c7 9.Bb3-a2 Pd7-d5!

[forced to legalize the move wBb3-a2 due to the additional white ep-option Pe5:d6ep(Pd2)]

10.RHh7-h3 & fw. 1.BH:e7(BHe8)#

Tries:

1.Ga4:Ra4(Ga8) Kh8-g8+...6.Bc4-b3? [starts the pendulum]

Qb6-c7 & 1.Kg8#/Re1#! [b5 is guarded, forw. defence]

1.Gc4:Ra4(Ga8)? Kh8-g8+2.BHh4:Bd8(BHd8) Qc7-h2+

3.Gg8-c4 Qb6-c7 4.RHh7-h3 Qc7-b6 5.Pg5:f6ep(Pf2) Pf7-f5 6.Ge6-g8

& v.1.BHf6# is defeated as Black moves better...3.Gg8-c4 **Re1-d1!**

4.RHh7-h3 Re6-e1! preventing...6.Ge6-g8!

...6.Gg6-g8? & fw. 1.BHf6+ G:g6(Gg1)! doesn't work

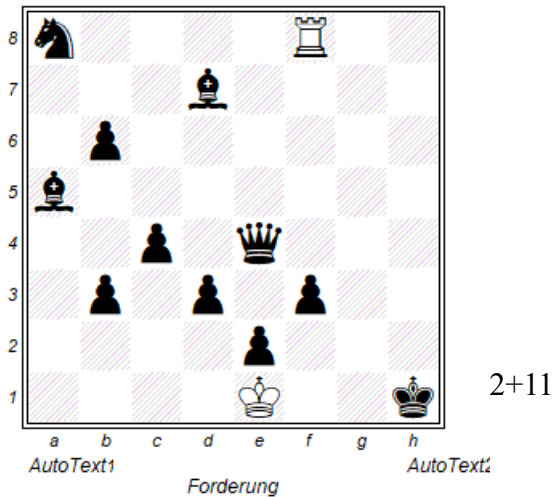

3.Kd1-c2 e3-e2+ 4.Kd2-d1 Rf1-f2+ 5.Ke2-d2 Qe7-e4+
6.Ke1-d2 Rf2-f1+ 7.Kd2:Pc2(Ke1) Rf1-f2+
8.Re8-f8 Qf8-e7+ 9.Ke1-d2 Rf2-f1+ 10.Kf1-e1
& fw. 1.Kg1+ Be1 stalemate
 ...8.Ke1-d2? Rf2-f1+ 9.Re8-f8 b4-b3+! 10.Kf1-e1
 & fw. 1.Kg1+? **Black** is mate, since the move bBe1 is impossible.

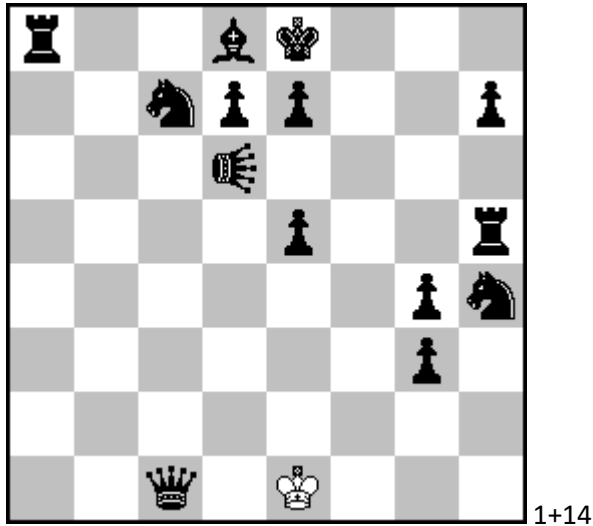
...7.Kd2-e1? Black declares type Calvet valid and requests according Hoeg the capturing move
 ...7.Kd2:Be1(Ke1)! In W10 this move would be illegal since 7 b pawns and 1 promoted bB are already on the board.

1.Kg6:Qh6(Ke1)! Kg8:Llg7(Ke8) 2.Kf6-g6 Rf8:Sf7(Ra8)

3.Kg5-f6 0-0+ 4.Llc3-g7 & fw. 1.Llc8#

In W1 the square h6 must be blocked to prevent the defence ...3.Kg5-f6 Kh8-g8+!
4.Sh6-f7+! White has the choice between 6 black units to uncapture. After decoy
of bKe8->g8/bRa8->f8 Black is forced to move back 0-0.

Thematical tries:

1.Kg6:Rh6? Kg8:Llg7+ 2.Kf6-g6? Illegal, double-check by P+R

1.Kg6:Bh6?...3.Kg5-f6? Illegal, bRf8 is pinned

1.Kg6:Sh6? 2.Kf6-g6 Sf7-h6+!

1.Kg6:Ph6?...3.Kg5-f6 0-0+ 4.? Llc3-g7 illegal, Llg7 is pinned

1.Kg6:Llh6?...3.Kg5-f6 Llh8-h6+!

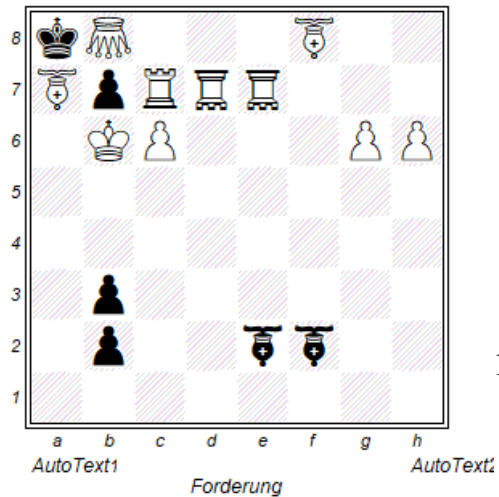

1.Gb8:Pb5(Gb8,Pb7)! Zugzwang b4-b3

2.g7:Bf8=BH(BHf8)! b3-b2

3.Gg3:Bb8(Gb8,Bf8) BHh4-f2 4.BHc5-a7

(prevents BHf2-e4) **BHe1-h4** (occupies the square of origin of wK) **5.RHb7-d7** (takes a flight of bK) & fw. **1.RH:e1(RHe8,BHe1)+ Ka7#**

1.g7:Bf8=BH(BHf8)? Pa6:Gb5/Pa5:Gb4(b7,Gb8)! 2.?

1.Gb8:Pb5(Gb8) Pa5:G/RH/BHb4(Pb7)! bPb7 must not remain on his square

The uncaptured bBf8 cannot recapture a w unit since 4 w fairy-pieces and 4 w pawns are already on the board. Thus the possible moves bB:wPe3,e5,f4,f6 are illegal. As all black squares on the b-line are occupied no w fairy piece may be recaptured on b-line by bBf8.

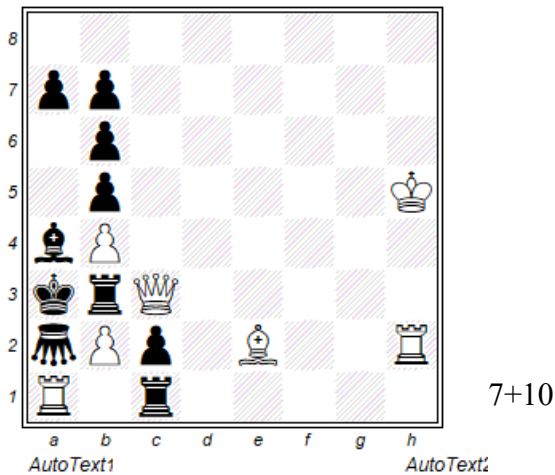

 ...3.Rh1-h2? G~a2 4.Ra1:xa2(Th1)+! is forced

1....Rb1-c1 2.Rc1-d1 Ra1-b1 3.Rh1-h2! Rb1-a1
 [forced] **4.f7:Ge8=R(Rh1) & fw 1.f8=G#**
 ...3.Bf1-e2? G~a2 4.Bb1:xa2+! is forced

1.Rd1:Gd4(Ra1) Ra1-c1 2.Rh1-h2? Rb1,c1-a1
 3.f7:Ge8=R(Rh1) & 1.f8=G+ R:b4(Rh8)+!
 1.Rd1:Gd4(Ra1) Rb1-c1 2.Bf1-e2? Ra1,c1-b1
 3.f7:Ge8=B(Bf1) & fw. 1.f8=G+ R:b4(Rh8)+!
 [the key unpinning Rb3 contains an Antizielelement]
 The tries: 1.Td1:Gd2,Gg1(Ra1)? Gf2,g2-d2/g2-g1=G!
 1.Rd1:Gd6,Gd8(Ra1)? are disturbing the forward play.
