Schwalbe, deutsche Vereinigung für Problemschach, and the local organizing committee have the honour to invite national representatives of the *World Federation for Chess Composition* (WFCC), national chess solving teams, individual solvers and composers and everybody interested in problem chess, to attend the jubilee **60th World Congress of Chess Composition** (WCCC) and **41th World Chess Solving Championship** (WCSC).

The congress will be held at the *Wyndham Garden Hotel* in Dresden, Germany, from Saturday, 5 August 2017 (arrival), to Saturday, 12 August (departure). The Open Solving will take place on Monday, 7 August 2017, and the WCSC on Tuesday and Wednesday, 8-9 August 2017.

The congress is organized as part of *Dresdner Schachsommer 2017* (Dresden Chess Summer, 29 July-12 August 2017) which also comprises the German Masters and the ZMDI Open (29 July-6 August 2017, an international OTB open tournament).
